<b>Note</b>	Danny has had both doses of the vaccine therefore reducing the risk to guests and to venue staff (as the chances of his being a covid transmitter are lower).

Hazard Type	Counter Measures	Further Action Required	Risk level
Covid transmission between the performer and guests / staff	1. Red Hat Magic will carry out a lateral flow test in the 24 hours prior to the event.	1. If a positive test is obtained a different performer or a refund will be offered.	1 Low
	2. On arrival Red Hat Magic will carry out any NHS track and trace requirements as directed by venue staff.	2. Red Hat Magic will check with the venue before the event to determine any venue specific requirements.	2 Low
	3. Red Hat Magic will wear a mask as required by the venue and by guests.	3. Red Hat Magic will check with the event lead as to their requirements.	3 Low
	4. Red Hat Magic will sanitise his hands on arrival and throughout the day.	4. Red Hat Magic will bring sanitiser.	4 Low
	5. Red Hat Magic will observe any venue specific requirements.

Hazard Type	Counter Measures	Further Action Required	Risk level
Transmission of the virus by touching infected items	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. New or sanitised props to be used</li><li>2. Guests asked if they are happy receiving cards etc. If they are not then hands off effects will be performed.</li><li>3. Guests offered hand sanitiser at the beginning and end of each session.</li></ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Performer to sanitise props no later than 24 hours before arrival.</li><li>2. Option of socially distanced routines where the guest does not touch anything and at a distance of 1 metre.</li><li>3. Hand sanitiser to be carried throughout the visit.</li></ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Low</li><li>2. Low</li><li>3. Low</li></ol>
